## School Attendance Update 1 - September 2022

Dear Parent/Carer,
The Department of Education has issued new guidelines on how schools are to monitor attendance from September. This means that the attendance policy for the Diamond Learning Trust will possibly change and that Headteacher's will need to challenge absences more.

There will be more monitoring of absences, lateness and the associated learning that has been missed. Your child's headteacher might request medical evidence if your child is poorly, or evidence of appointments. Without this, the absence could be unauthorised. The Headteacher's discretion to authorise holidays will also be reduced. We urge you where possible to make appointments outside of school hours.

Your child's attendance percentages are monitored and categorised as below:

| 98\% or above | Excellent |
| :--- | :--- |
| $95 \%-97.9 \%$ | Good |
| $92 \%-94.9 \%$ | Concerns |
| Below $91.9 \%$ | Serious concerns |
| Below $90 \%$ | Persistent absentee |
| Below 50\% | Serious Concerns |

$90 \%$ or below (persistent absentee), equates to one day absent per fortnight, or 20 days absent in a year or 1 term missed over 5 years. This adds up to an extremely large amount of work missed and means that continuity of learning is very difficult, if not impossible.

I must remind you that as parent(s) it is your legal responsibility, as stated under Section 444 of the Education Act 1996, to ensure that your child attends the school at which he/she is registered, regularly and punctually. Failure to do so may result in a Penalty Notice being issued against you and/or legal proceedings being considered.

Your child only need to be absent for 8 session in an 8 week period for this to apply. Or take an unauthorised term time holiday for 3 days or more.

When your child returns on $5^{\text {th }}$ September 2022, their attendance will start at $100 \%$. Please do all you can to ensure that this \% remains as close to $100 \%$ as possible. If your child is going to be absent for any reason then please contact your school office before 9am.
