Now the warmer weather is here, please can we remind you that children should have suncream applied before school in the morning. If it is sent in to school, bottles must be clearly named and children are not able to share their suncream with anyone else. Children should also be sent in with plenty of water to drink and sunhats.

School uniform reminder

We are noticing that there are lots of children in school not adhering to the school uniform policy and wearing inappropriate clothes.

Girls: White t-shirt or blouse, black or grey skirt or shorts (preferably not cycling shorts, however if these are worn they need to be knee length), blue and white summer dress/playsuit, socks must be worn, no open-toed sandals or flip flops for health and safety reasons.

Boys: White shirt or t-shirt, grey or black shorts or trousers.

PE kits: plain or logo t-shirts in team colours (no football/sports shirts), shorts and trainers.

Long hair should be tied back at all times. Earrings must be removed for PE.

Children will now also be practising for Sports Day. As stated previously, PE kits must be in school every day as they could be outside at any point. We do not have the time to be phoning parents every day that a kit is not brought in.

Attendance

We have seen a noticeable improvement in attendance generally across school and hope to see this continue until the end of term. It also means that hopefully we start the new academic year with the aim of 100% attendance for all!

Can we please remind you that where possible, medical evidence should be provided for any absences in order for them to be authorised.
