We will be using the following texts in our English reading lessons, focusing on retrieval and inference skills

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
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History

Maths

Our focus this summer will be upon fractions, length and perimeter, mass and capacity, money, time and shape.

Geography

In Geography this term our studies will be on countries and regions of the UK, before revisiting and building upon our map skills and fieldwork knowledge, focusing specifically on Ordnance Survey Maps.

Design Technology

In DT this term we are looking forward to learning about and creating our own pneumatic toys, and programming our own micro:bits to create an electronic charm.

Computing

This term children will use and explore Scratch, learning the difference between events and actions by creating a controllable sprite.

Science

This term we will be learning about forces and magnets, light, then building upon our existing knowledge of plants.

This term in religion and world views our learning questions will be: What happens if we do wrong? and Why is water symbolic?

In music we will be learning about pentatonic melodies,

Our Art studies will be based on abstract shape and space, in which we will be creating our own 3D sculptures as well as a textile unit taking inspiration from nature.

In PSHE, the units we are covering are Healthy Lifestyles, Managing Safety and Risk Digital Lifestyles (E-safety) and Relationships and Sex Education.

French

In French this term we will be looking at French transport- learning to say and recall the French names for common forms of transport We will also be looking at animal names and sounds and using our knowledge to create our own life cycles in French.

In PE this term the children will be developing their body control, co-ordination and rhythm in dance as well as getting outside to do some athletics and preparation for Sports Day.
