Year 1 - Mrs McMullen - Swift Class - "I can overcome challenges"

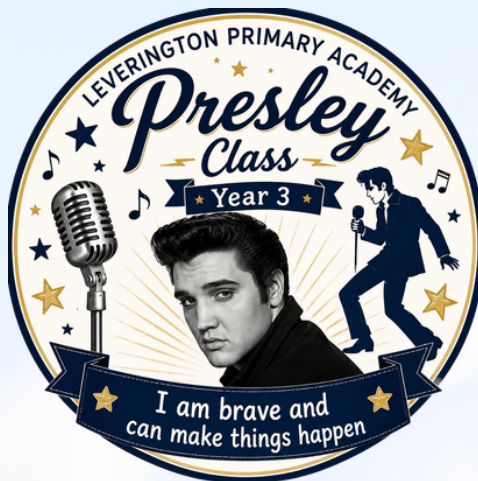
Year 2 - Miss Rutterford - Sheeran Class - "Everyone Belongs"
