We are excited to share a new initiative at Leverington, designed to celebrate and encourage excellent, valued lunchtime behaviour.

This has not been shared with the children yet, but will be introduced in January!

Each week, our Midday Supervisors and teaching staff will be on the lookout for children who consistently follow our lunchtime behaviour expectations, including:

Talking quietly to friends on their table
Using a knife and fork correctly
Showing good manners to staff and peers
Entering and leaving the dining hall sensibly
Cleaning their space and plates after eating

Each week, 3 children who display these valued behaviours will be invited to sit at 'The Golden Table' with a friend of their choice – this is a special, celebratory table reserved for those who have demonstrated the above. Pupils will enjoy a little extra recognition, being served first, sitting at the 'golden table' and the pride of being a fantastic role model to others!

We hope this initiative will help reinforce the valued behaviours we expect and create a safe, calm and respectful environment for all children.
