Reading

EDGE CLASS

This term we will be reading, "There's a Boy in the Girl's Bathroom" By Louis Sachar. This book will form the basis of our work for our writing and be our class reader.

Maths

We will be looking at solving fraction problems within the four main written operations and then extending our fraction knowlegde to other areas of maths such as measure and shape.
